### AUGUST YARD OF THE MONTH

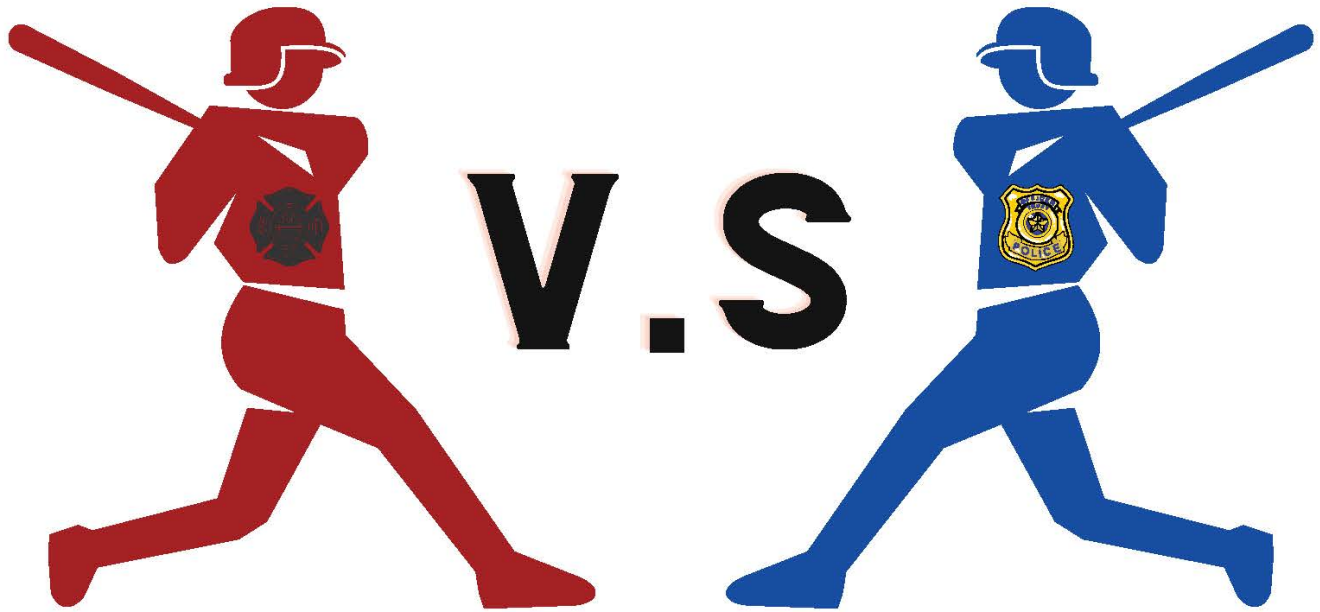
Mayor Ogden and The Yard of the Month Committee selected Terry and Kay Bennett as the August yard of the month.
