**CITIZENS ASKED TO USE CAUTION
WHEN FLUSHING**

Citizens are asked to be aware that flushing items such as napkins, paper towels, T-shirt fabric, rubber/plastic gloves, feminine hygiene products, and even baby wipes that say they are flushable, are hazardous to the sewer system.

Often times, when plumbers, or Public Works has to be called for a sewer back-up, the resident will say that the items they flushed said they were flushable on the package. What it *doesn't* say on the package, is that even though the item may go down when flushed, there is no guarantee that it won't clog the sewer pipes.

Please keep a bag-lined waste can next to your toilets, and dispose of these items in that can. Anything other than human waste and toilet paper will most likely clog the sewer lines and pump stations, causing a back-up, which could affect your homes.

It is easier and cheaper to use this preventative approach, than it is to clean up the mess caused by a sewer back-up.

The next Yard of the Month will not be awarded until December based off of your holiday decorations.




HALLOWEEN
