The Halloween parade is taking place Thursday, October 28th and Friday, October 29th, and begins each night at 5:30 p.m. The parade route has been posted on the Vine Grove City Hall Facebook page. Each night there will be a link posted on the Vine Grove Fire Department, and Vine Grove City Hall's Facebook pages. This tracker is called "Glympse", and allows you to see where the parade caravan is located in real-time. There is a slight delay in the mapping.
