ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE

No matter how well-behaved your animal is, they are not permitted to run at large. Citizens are asked to be mindful of their pets, and to maintain control of them at all times.

Ordinance number 90.02:

No person who is the owner of any animal shall permit it to run at large in any public road, highway, street, lane, or alley, or upon unenclosed land, or permit it to go on any private yard, lot, or enclosure without the consent of the owner of the yard, lot or enclosure.

Animals running at large are also at risk of being hit by a car, and getting lost or stolen. Animals that are not neutered or spayed may add to over population.

Please note that cold weather can be deadly for pets especially if they are left without food or water. Please reach out to law enforcement by calling the non-emergency number 270-351-4477 if you feel that pets do not have sufficient shelter, food, or water.

Hardin County Animal Control offers assistance in trapping, neutering, and releasing neighborhood cats. This program helps decrease the population. They also vaccinate against diseases, including rabies. This can also prevent behaviors such as a howling, fighting, and marking territory. If you see a cat with a clipped ear, this means they have been through the trap, neuter, and return program. It is humane. For more information please contact 270-769-3428.
