MAIN STREET DRAINAGE PROJECT

The Main Street drainage project has been an ongoing project discussed in the Vine Grove City Council meetings for over a year. The drainage system that conveys storm water underneath the roadway in several areas of the "downtown Vine Grove area" is in desperate need of repair. The city has coordinated with Kentucky Department of Transportation, and the railroad to gain permits for construction.

Starting in April, pending delivery of materials, Dirt Works will begin construction on the drainage system. It will affect traffic, and there will be an inevitable road closure. All traffic will be rerouted accordingly. This work must be completed in order to keep our citizens, and downtown businesses safe. The city asks that everyone please be patient while this construction project is underway. It is ultimately improving our City's infrastructure.
