HOW TO AVOID SEWER CLOGS

Fats, oils, and grease (FOG) are very harmful when poured down any drains in homes, apartments, or restaurants. This can lead to sewer back ups in your home, and even cause outside overflow.

Fats, oils, and grease need to be properly disposed of during food preparation and kitchen clean-up. When FOG is allowed to go down the drain it cools in the sanitary sewer lines creating buildup. The build up causes clogs and backups in your home.

To keep your drains FOG free:

- Pour cooled fats, oils and grease into a container, or plastic Ziploc bag and dispose of in the trash
- Before washing, use a paper napkin to wipe out any excess FOG
- Use sink strainers to catch food waste
- Put food scraps in the trash, and not the garbage disposal
